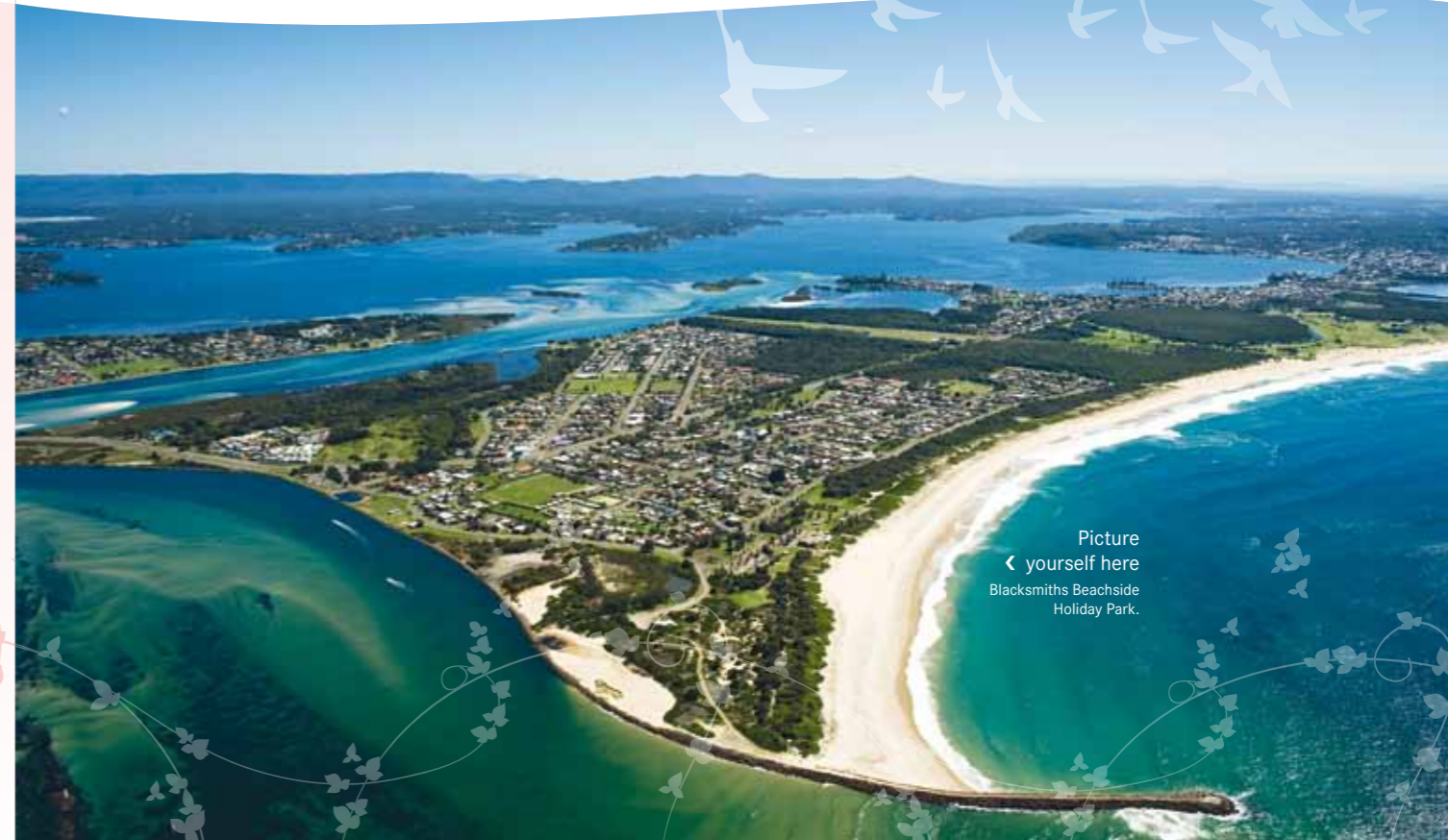
Swansea Gardens LAKESIDE HOLIDAY PARK
