

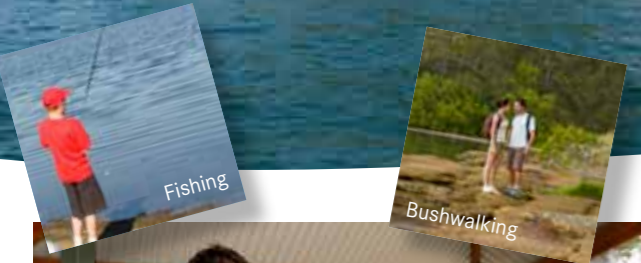

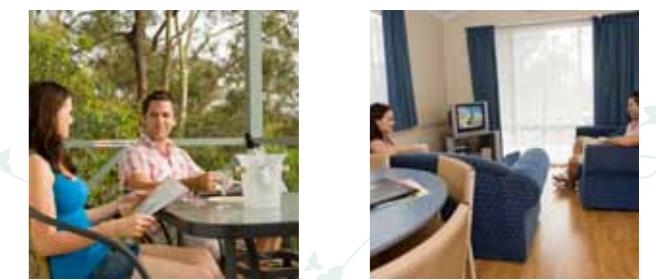

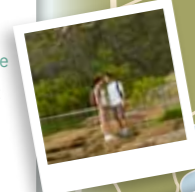
Sample Itinerary



Grab a coffee and set off to **Belmont Pines Lakeside Holiday Park**
Ph: 02 4945 4750 for a game of golf at Belmont Golf Club (ideally located on an isthmus between the Pacific Ocean and Lake Macquarie), some time on the kayak, and enjoy your favourite wine watching the unbelievable views of the sun set over the lake.

If you love art, get up early and follow the lake around to Lake Macquarie City Art Gallery (award winning regional gallery and sculpture park) and Dobell House (home and studio of the famous artist Sir William Dobell). Have a day trip to the Hunter Valley Wine Region to taste some incredible wines as well as the Hunter Valley Gardens (60 acres of stunning international display gardens). Take a short drive north of Swansea to **Blacksmiths Beachside Holiday Park**
